NEBRASKA GYMNASTICS MOURNS THE PASSING OF LINDA BOOKS

The gymnastics community lost a friend, Linda J. Books on June 7, 2005, after a courageous battle with cancer. As we know, Linda was involved in Nebraska gymnastics for over 20 years as a judge, coach and parent. She was a Level 10 judge and served as Nebraska State Judging Director from 1996-2004. While SJD, she was responsible for recruiting and training many of our new judges. But more importantly, Linda was a caring,

funny, wonderful person. During the gymnastics seasons, we traveled with Linda to many places, including South Dakota, Missouri, Iowa, North Dakota, and Florida. During those weekends, we were fortunate to share some of Linda's life. We shared Linda's anticipation when her son, Brad, came home from overseas while serving in the military. We watched and shared in Linda's excitement as daughter Andra left home for college, got married,

became a judge herself, and started a family of her own. Linda is survived by her husband John, son Brad, daughter Andra, son-in-law Brad, and granddaughter, Callie. We were blessed to have Linda touch our lives and she will be greatly missed. In Linda's honor, the NE USA Committee will be donating \$100 to the Methodist Hospital's Cancer Center.
